- My dear bros and sisters, Assalalamu alaikum w.r.t.





DISCUSSIONS	

Secretary provided his reports and briefing on the Sub-Committees activities, and Sub-Committee Coordinators and the team members. He appreciated the sincere efforts and works by each Sub-committee which brought the Canberra Muslim Community and Gungahlin Mosque to its present shape. Secretary has also requested the attendees to see the full activity reports when it will be in the website. Full reports are as below:

Mosque Management Sub-Committee Coordinated by Br Akramul Huq and his team:

- Mosque Management Sub-Committee (MMC) brothers are closing and opening masjid doors, and activates security systems code every day after Isha, and before Fajr.
- MMC brothers keep masjid and surrounding area tidy, undertake Friday Jummah preparation- Every Thursday night brothers are arranging a big cleaning of carpet including sister's area.

- Brothers are clearing carpets at least twice a week, if necessary, they clean it each day as well.
- Brothers are cleaning and keep tidy kitchen and veranda on regular basis.
- MMC brothers clean air-conditioning units.
- Brothers are updating community notice board, and masjid doors on various programs and activities, like regular lectures by visiting sheikh, masjid open day programs, etc.
- Brothers are updating prayer time table on the clock, social media and make announcement on regular basis.
- Coordinate cleaning of both bathrooms and wheelie bins.
- During Ramadan brothers are coordinating to pick up big wheel bins as required.
- MMC brothers monitor and keep on eyes on all equipment's make sure they are in working conditions, etc.

Women Sub-Committee Co-ordinated by Sister Meherun Nisa and her team:

During 2019, the Women Sub-Committee conducted a number of programs for children and women in the community. The following are just to name a few activities.

Kids Program:

- Several school holiday programs
- Stories about Prophet Nuh (PBUH)

Activities for ladies:

- Regular Quran Classes every Wednesday and Friday of the week.
- On 10 April 2019, the sub-committee facilitated Gungahlin mosque visit by a group of school teachers from Bonner primary school. The committee welcomed around 40 teachers from Neville Bonner Primary School to the mosque. We had the opportunity to share information about religious observances like Eid, Ramadan, Hajj and halal food requirements. It was great to see such interest from public educators to better support the young people in their care.
- On 12 June 2019, sisters from the sub-committee helped organise Eid ul Fitr celebration at Taylor Primary School. This was a great event and enjoyed by Muslim and non-Muslim families of the school. There were several questions asked by participants regarding Islam which was a great opportunity to spread words about our religion and about us too. Many activities took place, for example, face and henna painting,

signing of a big size Eid card by the participants in various languages, including Arabic, Bengali, Malayalam, Bahasa Indonesia, just to name a few.

IT Management Sub-committee Coordinated by Br Rafiqul Sherif and his team:

IT team's activities during the last fiscal year include the following, some of them are completed and many more are on the ways:

- Live Broadcasted of major events including Ramadan, Taraweeh, Eid, Meetings, AGM Mission Statement, and Islamic lectures
- Designing all sorts of template specially Ramadan calendar and fundraising events, etc.
- Managing and maintaining all mosque billing accounts, social networking and mosque promotional activities for the mosque.
- Regularly maintaining our web pages, email accounts and email correspondences from EC to members
- Set up extended donation boxes, collected donation and forwarded to CMC account and confirmed to treasurer.
- Engaged in various mosque related purchases and maintained accounts.
- Worked together with GMIS for their setup including website, templates, logo design, etc.
- Created campaign materials including Mosque open day tear drops or flag pole and street sign for Mosque open days.
- Drafted additional land application
- Drafted grants applications and managing acquittal of the grants
- Assisting membership team and election panel
- Assisted CMC President to take minutes and meeting notes of additional land application

In progress:

- NBN connections is on the way cable is laying at this stage expecting in October 2019.
- Mosque new central display, live broadcast and extended sound systems
- IT team is tirelessly working with all activities happening in the mosque.

- Led Refugee march at Civic, with CMC Muslim banner at the forefront

- Organized and facilitated participation and attendance of non-Muslim guests at our mosque events, including Iftars
